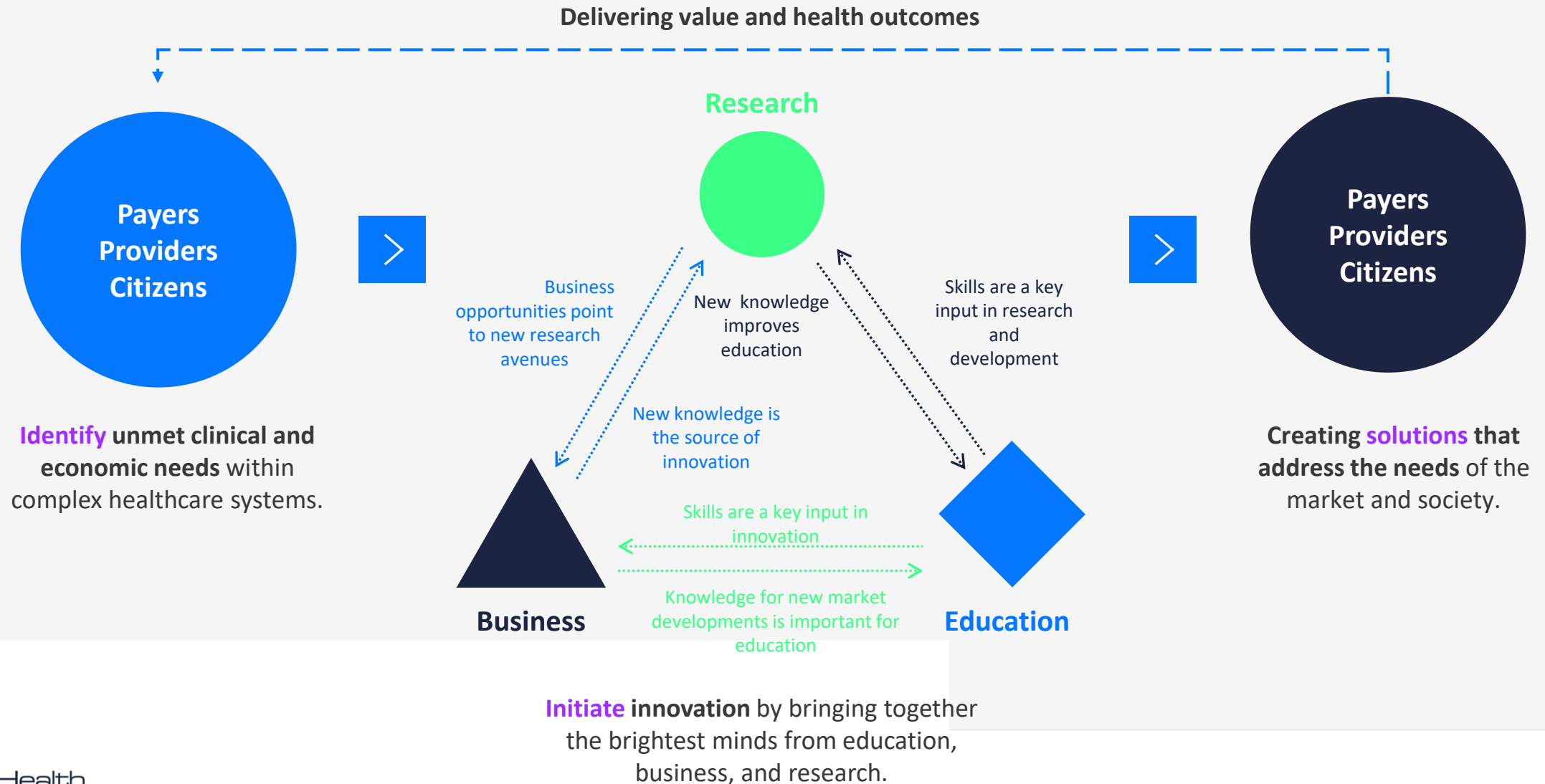

EIT Health has built Europe's largest health innovation network connecting approximately 150 world-class organisations and entities from business, research, education and healthcare delivery.

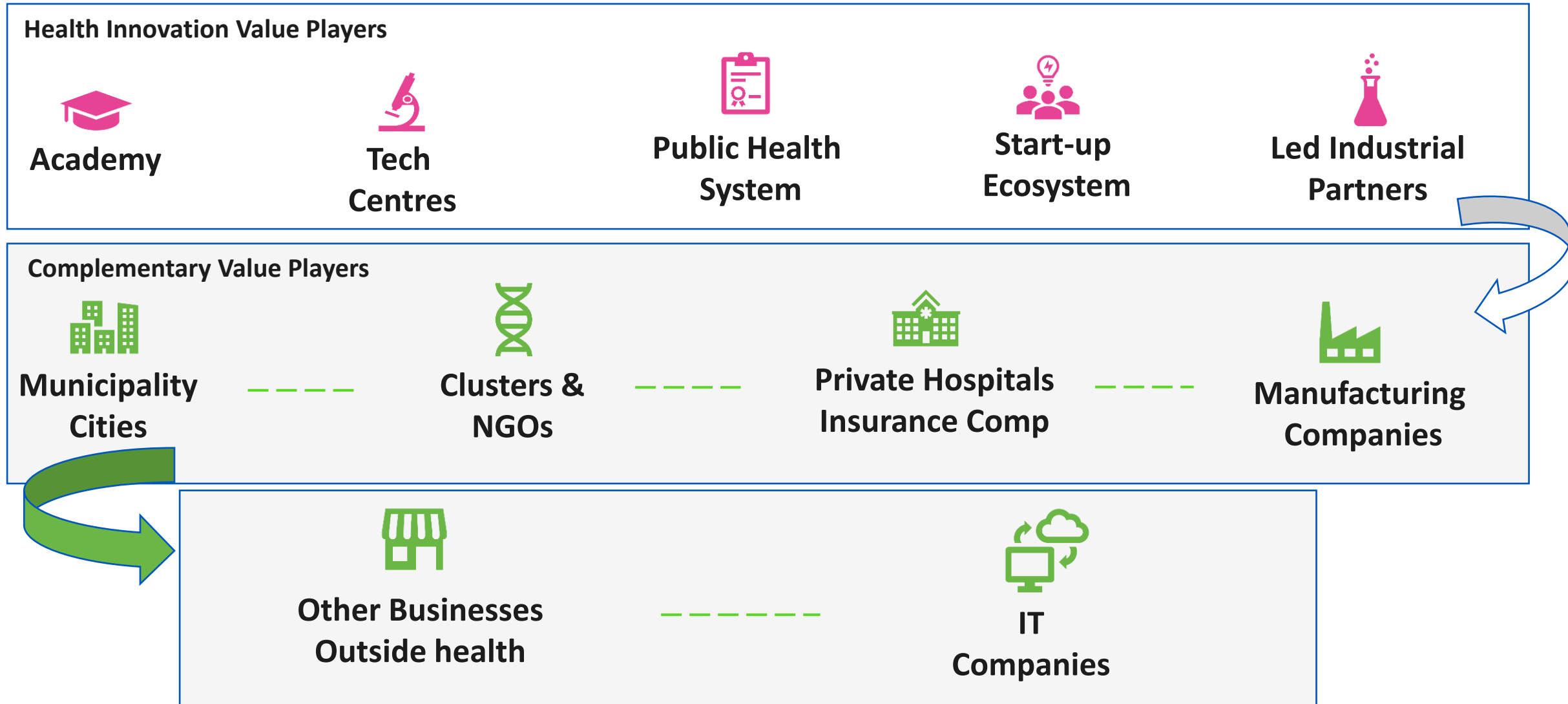

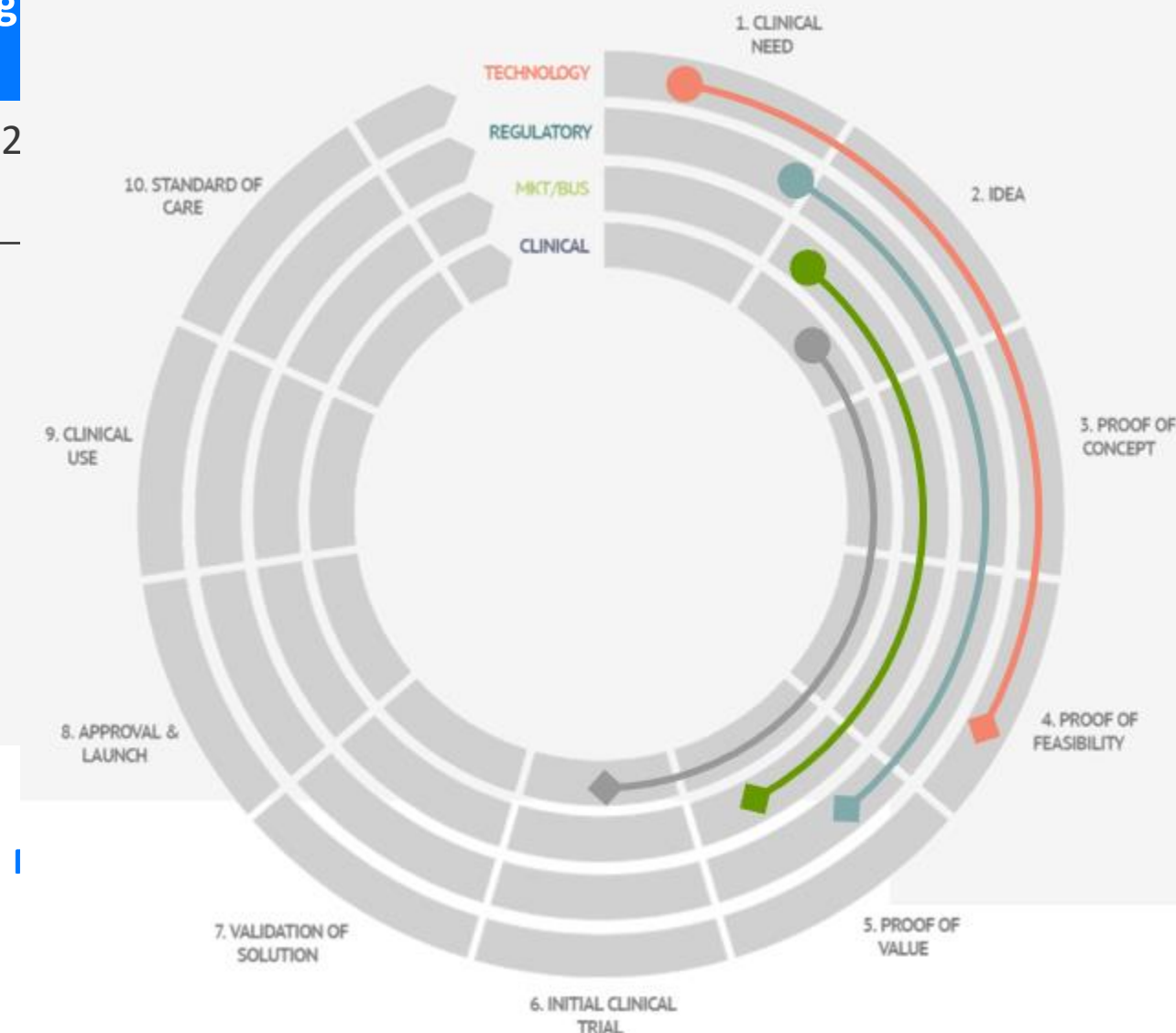

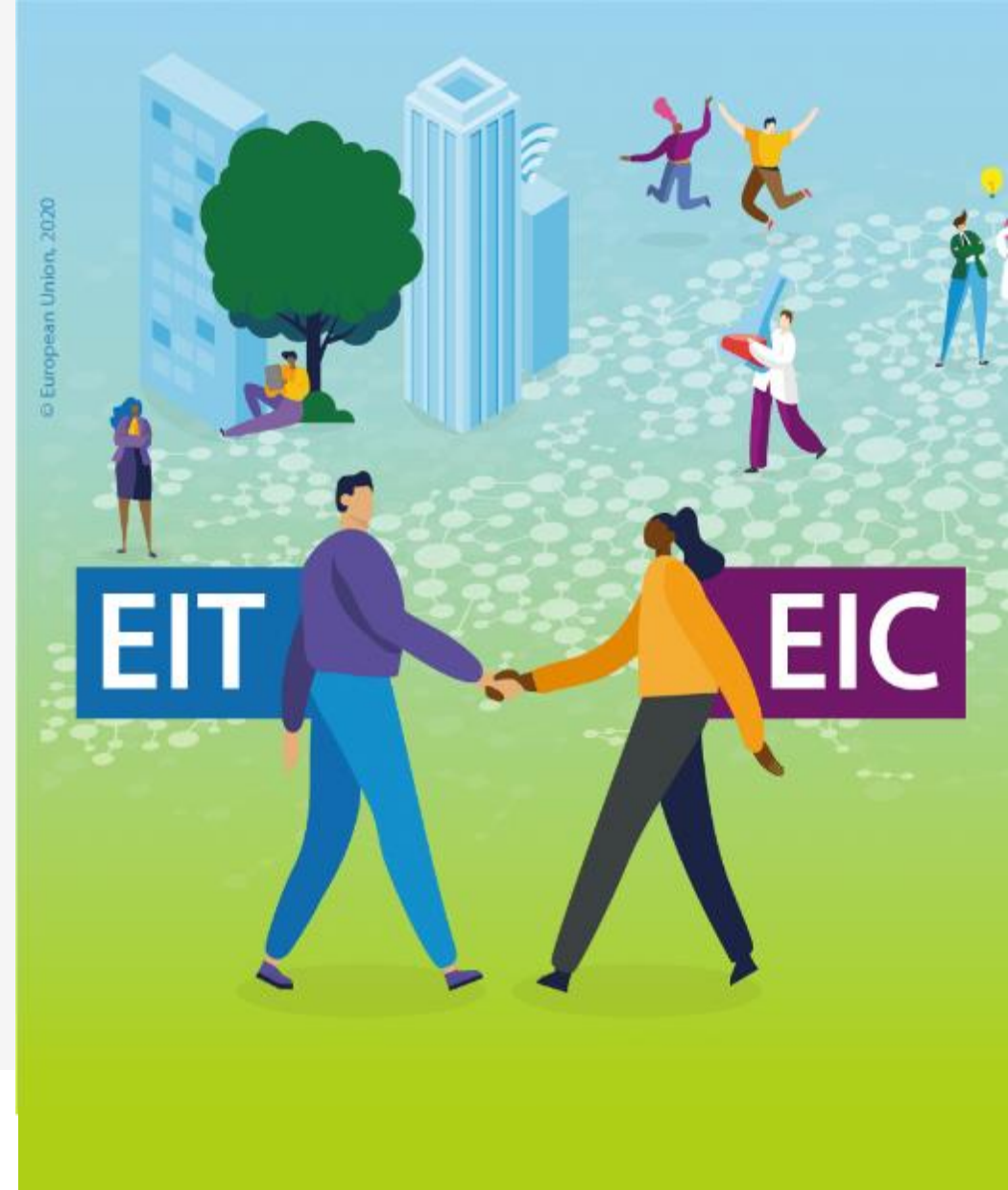
The EIC & EIT Health Pilot Collaboration
